Beulah Taylor and Jack Hill married at Guntersville First United Methodist Church April 3, 1948. She and Jack remained members and raised their daughters at Guntersville First United Methodist Church. At the time of her death she was the longest standing member of the church.

Beulah graduated from Arab High School and Business College. She met her future sister-in-law Ruth Hedricks Hill at Business College. They went to Washington D. C. and worked at the Pentagon during World War II. They became best friends and roommates in Washington D.C. Our family grew up hearing what a great time they had as young ladies from rural Sand Mountain. Ruth married Charles Hill after WWII and that is when Beulah was introduced to Jack Hill. They were married 45 years until his death in 1993.

Beulah became a mother and a homemaker. She was a great cook and great seamstress. She loved her family, her church, and her friends.
