



Charles Thomas Strachan

June 7, 1919 - March 24, 2013

Charles Thomas "Charlie" Strachan of Guntersville died Sunday, March 24, 2013, at Magnolia Trace in Huntsville after an extended period of poor health. He was 93.

Charlie was born and raised in Bedford, Ohio where he began a lifelong passion for aviation. He served as a B-24 aircraft commander at the end of WWII, flew and sold helicopters for Bell Corporation in the 1950's and worked as the helicopter operations director for a firm involved in oil exploration in the jungles of Peru.

Charlie and his wife, Lois, made their home in Guntersville in the middle 1980's where he worked as the manager for Agri-flavors. While in Guntersville, Charlie enjoyed his involvement with RSVP, the Guntersville Museum, his friends, and the areas' great natural beauty. He is survived by his son Jack Strachan (Joyann), his step-daughter Linda Joseph, and family members in Arizona, Colorado, Florida, and New York.

He was preceded in death by his first wife Ellen, his second wife Lois, his brother Bryce, and his step-son, Richard Joseph.

A private memorial service will be held at a later date in Bedford, Ohio.
