



## Donald Morgan

July 19, 1933 - February 29, 2012

Mr. Donald M. Morgan of Omaha, NE passed away on February 29, 2012. He was 78 years old. He was born July 19, 1933 in Guntersville, AL to James and Bonnie Morgan.
