Gary Patrick Bullock, 60, of Scottsboro, Alabama passed away in the home that he loved on Thursday, July 1, 2021. Gary was born in Reno, Nevada and since he was a small child had a larger than life personality. Gary went all state in wrestling and football, earning him a scholarship to Troy University where he earned his bachelor of science degree in accounting and business/management in 1984, and then went on to earn his MBA in 2002 from Lake Forest Graduate School of Management. But he would say his greatest success was maintaining close relationships and being a great father to his two children, Colton and Savannah Bullock.

After completing 36 years at Allstate Insurance Company, Gary was ready to start the next chapter in his life. He moved to Scottsboro, AL and many would say this is where his life really began. Gary could have written the book on how to live a retired life. He quickly began mowing the golf greens next door to his house for free golf, bought a boat, joined and became the president of the Homeowners Association, joined the Master Gardeners Program, and his greatest joy was becoming a volunteer firefighter for the Waterfront Volunteer Fire Department; He became the treasurer and was even awarded Firefighter of the year. He joked that 30 years of working in insurance made him want to run into burning buildings.

He is predeceased by his father Walter Harold Bullock; and his siblings,

Walter Harold Bullock Jr. and Sandra Lee Trottier. He is survived by his children, Colton James Bullock and Savannah Lee Bullock (Anthony Velardi); his mother Beatrice Baker (Larry); his siblings, Lawrence Bullock, Jeffery Baker (Brandi), Wanda Mangum, Linda Wodnick and Penny Jones; his sister-in-law Donna Bullock; his nieces and nephews, Tricia, Tiffany, Billy, Caroline, Lucy, Peter, Jeremy, Catrina, Cristina, Dennis Jr, Jacobi, Julian, Rylan and Brayden; and his precious pets, Cassius, Randy, and Mr. Fox and cousins, aunts, uncles, and many other extended family members. We also enjoyed the Chicago Blackhawks' Stanley Cup years, and once, he, Bonnie, my wife Sherri and I watched a great playoff win from the upper skybox behind the visiting side goal.

During one of our trips to golf in Galena, Illinois, Gary introduced me to "whiskey in a jar" - a concoction of rye, scotch and bourbon (or maybe just whiskey as the third key ingredient).

Gary was also well known for this kind of approach at work: "blah, blah, blah (I am paraphrasing some solution to a problem), blah, blah, blah." Followed by him ducking his chin a bit, looking over the top of his glasses and ending with "Right???" Followed by his signature kind of a laugh. He did laugh a lot - brief, but to the point.

Back a while ago, there was a commercial for GEICO, a competitor of Allstate's that featured a camel walking around an office asking everyone what day it was. Well, part way through was the part that Gary would shout out to me across the floor "Mike, Mike, Mike, Mike, what day is it?" Of course, always on a Wednesday, also known as hump day. I think that went on for as long as Gary worked with me.

Our last exchanges centered on golf, a little bit of family and a little bit of health. Back in March he told me of his feeling drained at the end of the day. I had not heard of long-haulers effect of COVID at the time.

I invited him to join me and group to golf in Scotland this August. His quick reply 'wedding this year'. I asked if it was him, or one of the kids. That led to an exchange of thoughts. In early May, a message from Gary showed up "guess who's coming to town" with an obligatory selfie. From there, we made plans to golf while he was here. He was excited to see his kids and see Savannah's new

house. And golf.

I last saw Gary on June 18th and we greeted each other with a big man-hug when we met at a local golf course. We exchanged some health, happiness and life experiences during our time together. At the end though, he offered me his guest bedroom, to come down and play some golf on the nearby Robert Trent Jones trail. That was a goal. Almost a plan. I jokingly said "after hurricane season", knowing that any gulf hurricane would usually dump a lot of water on Gary and his horticultural work. It was not meant to be.

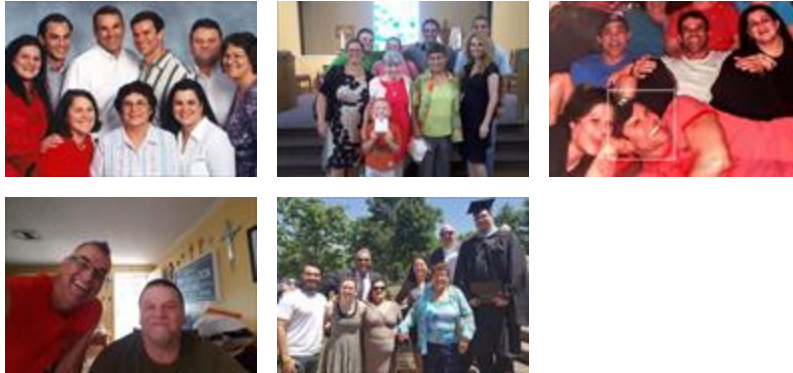

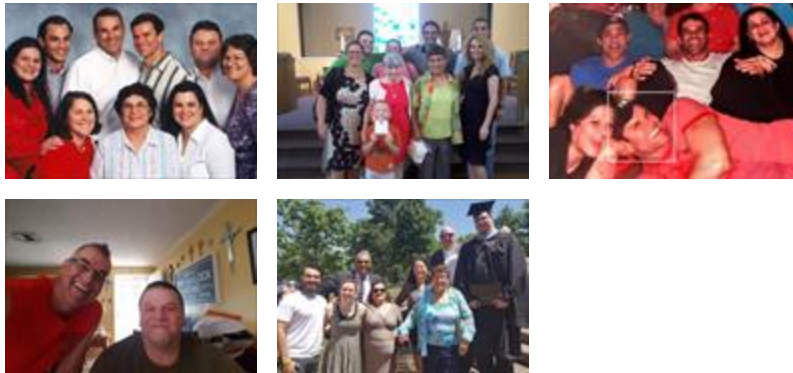

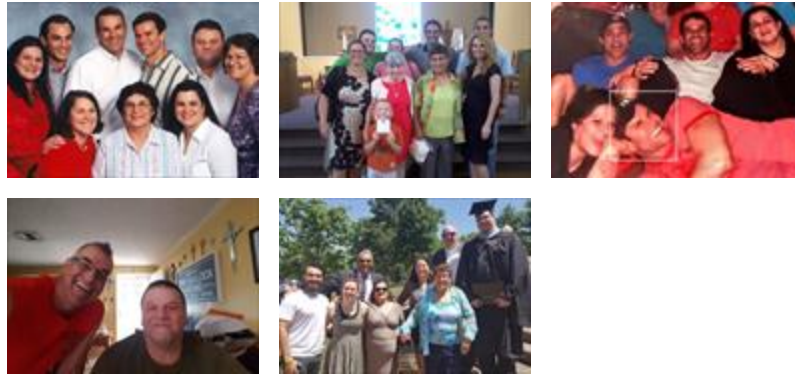
