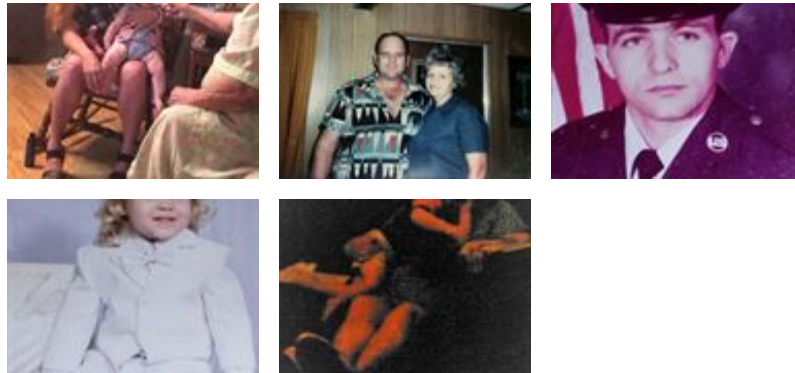
“ Wow so many memories over the last 16 yrs!
